

Life Agents Remain Strong in November CYOC Program



It's a race to the finish line, and Life agents continue to heat up the Chart Your Own Course standings.

Nick Fortier of Smith & Eddy Insurance, Inc. landed in sixth place, joining the top ten and qualifying for Gold Level 2. Fortier has \$10,219 in life insurance premium and 18 policies issued.

Patriot Insurance Company agent Angela Sawyer of Insurance Shoppers Inc. takes seventh place and remains at Gold Level 1. Sawyer has \$8,511 in life insurance premium and 20 policies issued.

Marc Schol of Schol & Associates, Inc. made the top ten for the first time, landing in eighth place, and qualifying for Gold Level 1. Schol has \$8,449 in life insurance premium and 18 policies issued.
