

Patriot Insurance Company Suspends Binding Authority Due to Tropical Storm Henri

As a result of the threat posed by Tropical Storm Henri, Patriot Insurance Company is suspending binding authority in Maine, New Hampshire, and Vermont as of 5 p.m. EST on Friday, August 20, 2021.

This binding authority suspension will remain in effect until further notice and applies to new business as well as increases in limits or additions of coverage on in-force policies.

Home office approval is required to override the suspension. We will continue to monitor the situation and inform you when the suspension is no longer in effect. Please contact your field manager or underwriter with any questions regarding this binding authority suspension.
